Sea View Inn Women's Retreat with Lee Brockington Pawleys Island, S.C.

Tuesday, Oct. 27 – Thursday, Oct. 29, 2026

For more than a decade, local treasure Lee Brockington has been celebrating history, ecology and sisterhood at the Sea View Inn (open since 1937). You can be one of the limited number invited to join her at "girls camp," eating Gullah meals prepared and served by Gullah women, and learning lessons of time and tide.

There will be talks on the front porch, back porch, deck and dock which are complemented by walks on the beach and along the creek to enhance your understanding of Waccamaw Neck history and Pawleys Island ecology.

Bring your slippers, cozy pj's, and adult beverage(s) of your choice.

Day 1 – Tuesday, 10/27:

Plan to arrive at noon on Tuesday - drop your bags in your room, say hello to Lee and meet your new 'Sea View Sisters'. Then relax on the front covered porch in a rocking chair while watching and listening to the waves roll in.





The dinner bell will ring at 1:15pm, when you will take a seat in the dining room for a delicious feast of Sea View Inn's famous fried chicken with all the fixin's, along with dessert. Join Lee for talks on local history and even some famous ghosts of the area! Appetizers and light supper that evening - BYOB.

Day 2 – Wednesday, 10/28:

A full breakfast of eggs cooked to order, bacon or sausage, pancakes, grits, toast, cereal & yogurt, fruit and juice will be served in the dining room at 8:30am.

After breakfast, come along on a Creek Walk while Lee discusses salt marsh flora and fauna, historic houses and places. Join in or sleep in, the time is yours to enjoy! The dinner bell will ring at 1:15pm, and you will savor in another delicious feast of Sea View Inn's Seafood Quiche and a Cobb Salad Buffet, along with dessert. After the midday meal and rest hour, enjoy a Beach Walk with Lee as she discusses tides, shells, birds, and tide pools. Appetizers and light supper that evening - BYOB.



Day 3 – Thursday, 10/29:

After a full breakfast, served at 8:30am, and packing up, there will be one last session before saying goodbye at about 10:00am.
