DAY 1 - 2/23:

Upon arrival at the Jekyll Island Club Resort, you will have time to explore the resort's lush, manicured grounds or just curl up with your favorite book in one of the many fireplaced libraries. This evening we will gather to enjoy a buffet dinner together in the Grand Dining Room at the Resort.

DAY 2 - 2/24:



After breakfast at the Resort, we will enjoy a guided History Tour of the Jekyll Island Club Hotel led by an on-site resort historian. This walk explores the original Clubhouse and recounts stories of the island's 19th-century millionaires that visited. After lunch (pay on your own) we will take a 10 minute walk to visit the Jekyll Island History Museum - Mosaic. Later that afternoon we will enjoy High Tea in the Grand Dining room. You will be on your own for dinner that evening.

3 DAY 3 – 2/25:

After breakfast at the Resort, we will board the motorcoach and drive to St. Simons Island with its fascinating museums and unique shopping along its charming streets. It's no wonder Southern Living named St. Simons Island on its list of Best Coastal Small Towns! Upon arrival, we will visit the World War II Home Front Museum. The Museum is housed in the Historic St. Simons Coast Guard Station, built in 1936. Step back to April 8, 1942, when the crew from this station rescued survivors of two American ships torpedoed by a German U-boat 13 miles off St. Simons Island. You will be inspired by the stories of ordinary Americans doing their part to win the war. After lunch (pay on your own) and shopping, we will hop on board the St. Simons Trolley. You'll enjoy this informative and entertaining tour, riding on a vintage 1930s trolley, which takes you to the island's historic sites. Afterwards, we will board our motorcoach for the return to Jekyll Island for the evening. Dinner will be on your own.

4 DAY 4 – 2/26:

After breakfast at the Resort, we will take a 5 minute walk to the Georgia Sea Turtle Center for a tour. The Center is Georgia's only hospital for turtle treatment, research and rehabilitation. You can explore the lives of sea turtles and other native animals through their exhibits. Glimpse into the hospital where sea turtles are treated and see their turtle patients in the rehabilitation pavilion. We will then walk back to the resort and prepare for our departure. We will stop for lunch (pay on your own) and we will arrive back home in the late afternoon.

MOTORCOACH TRANSPORTATION
