DAY 1 – 2/3:

We will travel by motorcoach to Camden, S.C. with Historian Lee Brockington. Upon arrival in Camden, we will visit the Revolutionary War Visitor Center, along with a tour of the Kershaw House. Camden's 250-year-old history ranging from the Revolutionary War era to the antebellum South to the winter residences established in the early 1900s. Camden was at the center of some of the hardest fighting between the American's and British in the struggle for our independence.

After lunch, we will visit Camden Museum & Archives. We will then settle into our hotel rooms for a rest before going to dinner together.



DAY 2 – 2/4:

We will have an early breakfast at the hotel, followed by a morning visit to the stables at the Springdale Racecourse. This is where the running of the Carolina Cup takes place each spring with thousands attending for a day of tailgating parties and horse races. We will then have a guided tour of the Steeplechase Museum.

After checking out of the hotel and boarding our motorcoach, we will stop for lunch. As we head home we will make time for a quick visit to Buc-ee's, arriving back home in the late afternoon.
